

# HOUGHTON-LE-SPRING HERITAGE WALK



The Houghton Heritage Walk is a guided walk led by Houghton Heritage Society Chairman and local historian, Paul Lanagan.

The walk, lasting around two hours, will take in many of Houghton's historic buildings and noteworthy locations (including some on uneven ground and via steps). Attendees will hear of Houghton-le-Spring's little known heritage but there is also ample opportunity for you to share what you know!

Interested children are welcome to attend but must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Some of the Houghton Heritage Walks do not require you to book – you just turn up; in this case, the start location will be publicised, otherwise will be given when you book a place.
