INGREDIENTS

Apples
Golden syrup
Cornflakes
Cream (whipped)

METHOD

1. Cook apples as for pie.
2. Mix cornflakes with golden syrup (warm jar etc, comes out easier) then spread over the apples.
3. Top with cream.
