

Please be aware that restrictions will be in place at key times for Houghton Feast. Please follow local signage. If you need to park in a different place, please be respectful of other road users and residents. **RECTORY PARK CAR PARK** - This car park will close at 4:30pm on Friday October 3<sup>rd</sup> (tbc). Access will also be restricted on Saturday October 4<sup>th</sup> between 1:30pm and 4:00pm (tbc). **DAIRY LANE (LEADING INTO THE BROADWAY)** - This road will be closed on Friday October 3<sup>rd</sup> between 4:30pm and 10:00pm, and on Saturday October 4<sup>th</sup> between 1:30pm and 4:00pm (tbc). Other road closures may be in operation, particularly on Saturday October 4<sup>th</sup> for the Carnival Parade, and Monday October 6<sup>th</sup> for the fireworks display (crowd control).
