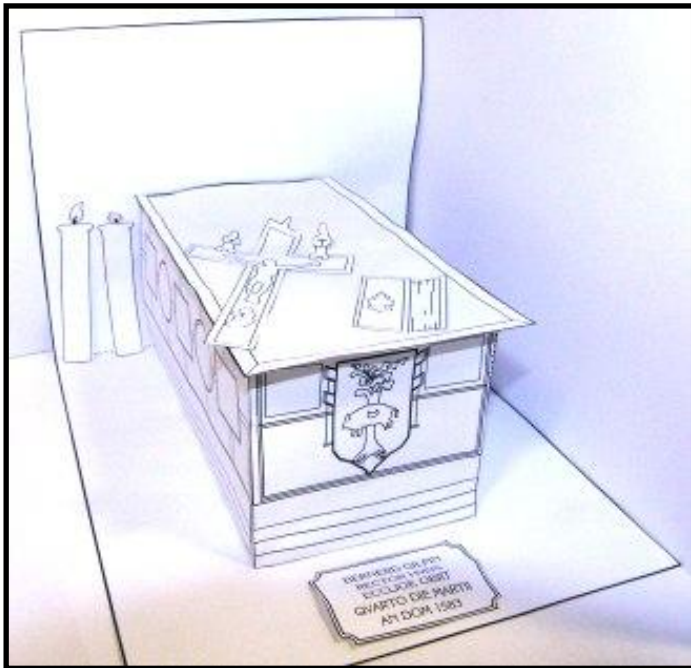




# BUILD THE TOMB OF BERNARD GILPIN

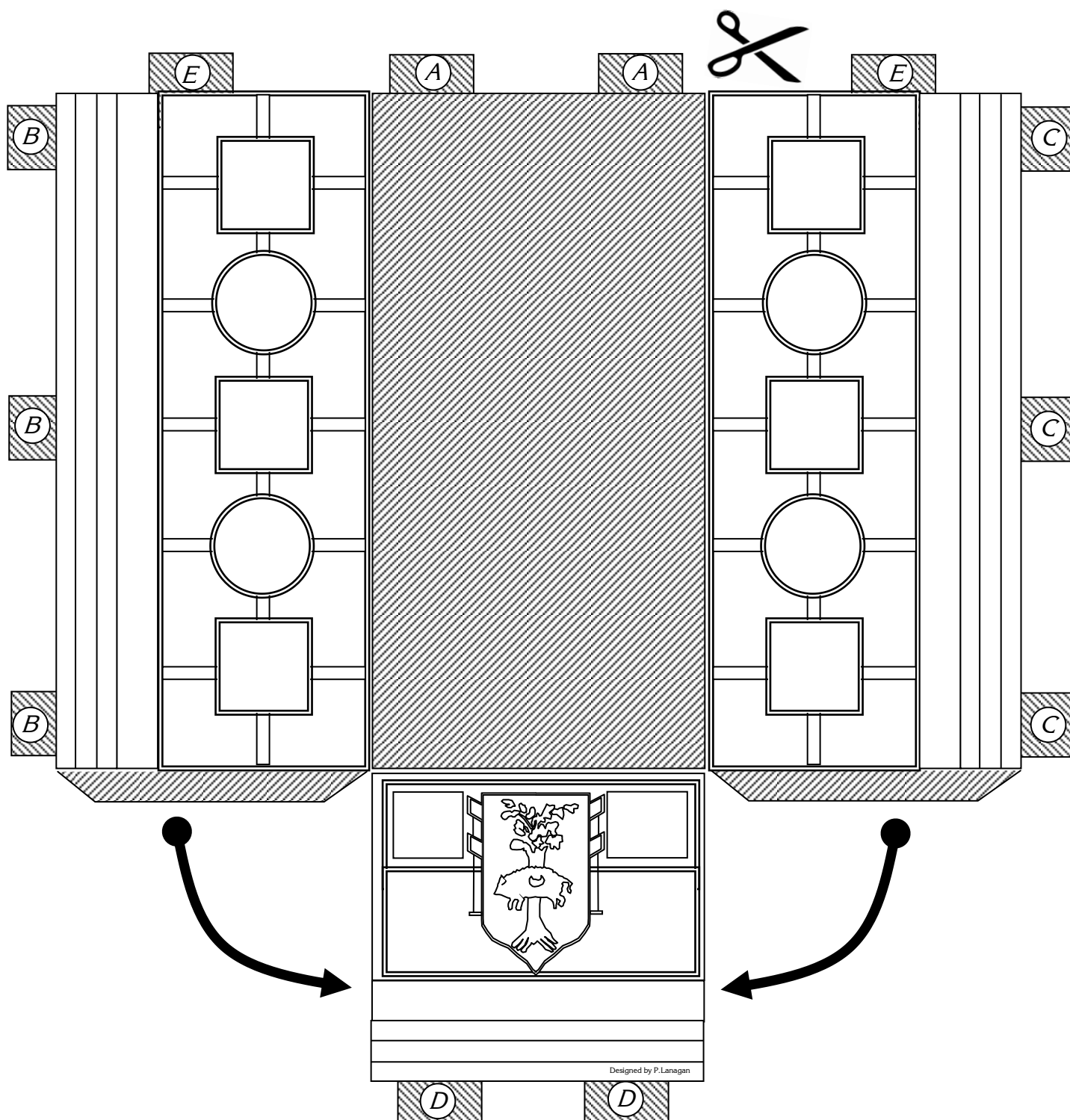
RECTOR OF HOUGHTON-LE-SPRING  
1558 - 1583



1. Decorate your card pieces using felt tips or poster paints.
2. Cut out the pieces – the tomb, the floor and wall base, the lid, and Bernard Gilpin.
3. TOMB – glue the tabs to the sides to make a cuboid shape.
4. FLOOR/WALL - bend along the dotted line.
5. Carefully place Bernard Gilpin inside the tomb (cuboid) then glue it into place on the base.
6. Glue the lid on top.
7. Decorate the tomb with flowers and evergreens. During Houghton Feast the Church's jewels and treasures would be on display here.

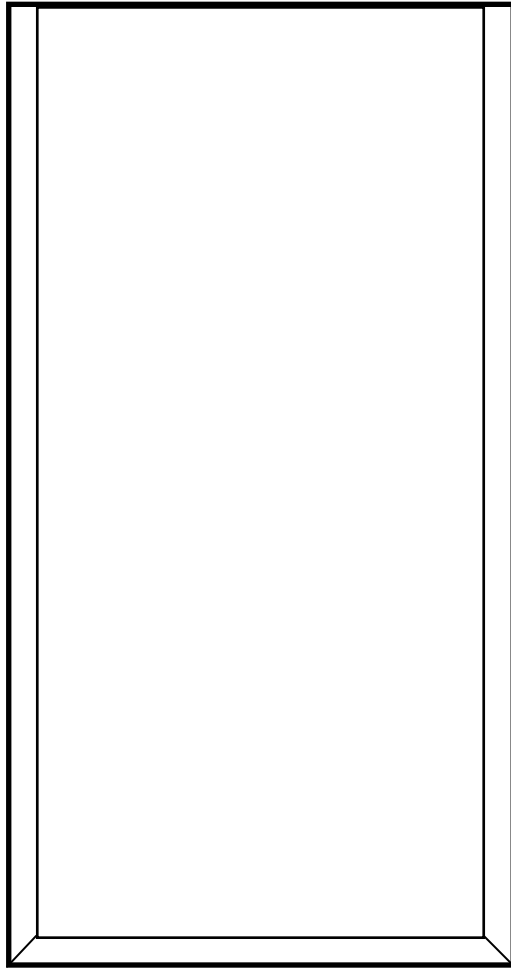

(BASE)

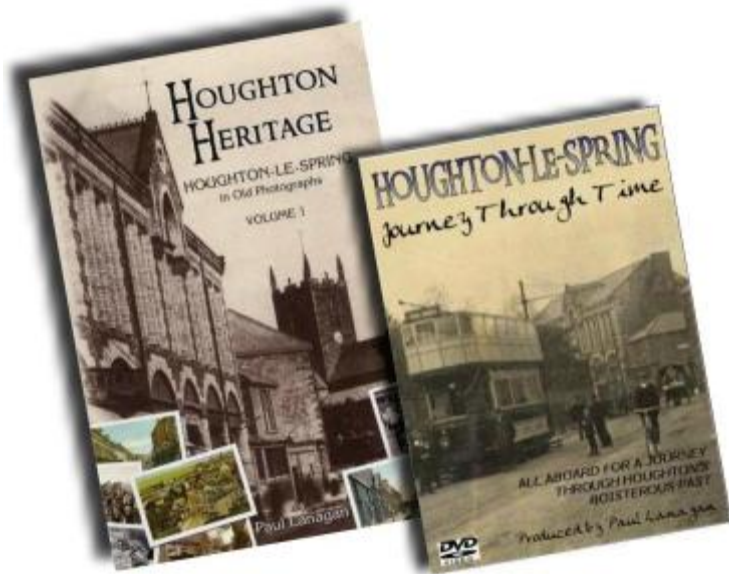
